Purpose of the Award

The New Zealand Association Parking award is an annual award for excellence in parking, organised by the parking executive. Now in its 5th year, the purpose of the award is to:

- ◆ recognise excellence in contribution to the NZ parking industry
- ◆ Create role models for Parking Association Members
- ◆ Encourage professionalism in the parking profession
- ◆ Acknowledge the creation of innovation systems and/or technology development in the parking business

Presentation of the Award

The award will be presented at the annual conference to be held 2-5 October 2007 at the Devon Hotel, New Plymouth. The winning nominee will be presented with an engraved trophy.

Award Eligibility

Any member of the NZ Parking Association.

Guideline

This award of the Association shall be made at the discretion of the parking executive judging panel.

Guidelines for Judging Criteria

The following guidelines are provided to assist you when making a nomination, particularly in developing the Statement of Achievement for the nominee.

1. Initial assessment of the nominations will be on the strength of their applications and supporting information
2. It is desirable that the person should be nationally recognised for their activities and contribution.
3. The award is not for long service but is for a contribution that is in line with the New Zealand parking association's vision, mission and goals.
4. The contribution could be made by a person, council or company

Judging Panel

Shall consist of:

- ◆ The president of the New Zealand parking association (who shall chair the panel)
- ◆ Two other members of the parking executive

The panel is responsible for the final decision and will not enter into any correspondence on the awards.

NO information about the decision of the panel will be given prior to the official announcement.

Should in the event that one of the judges or their employers be nominated they will step down and a reserve panel member will stand in. The reserve panel member will be selected from the parking executive.

Rules

- ◆ Entries must be submitted to the NZ parking executive no later than 1 September 2007.
- ◆ Entries must be made using the official entry form available from AssociationInfo@nzparking.com
- ◆ Entries must relate to contributions made between September 2006 & September 2007.
- ◆ Nominations are generally provided in confidence and generally without the prior knowledge of the nominee but under the Privacy Act nominees have the right to approach the parking executive committee judges to view the information provided.
